CRITERIA FOR FORFEIT

- 1. Team is not present**
- 2. Team is unable to field 5 players ready to play 15 minutes after scheduled game time**
- 3. Team's actions prevent the game from being played**
- 4. Team refuses to play after being instructed by Crew Chief**

PENALTY

- Game awarded to opponents with score 20 – 0**
- Forfeiting team receives 0 classification point**

Team forfeits twice  **Disqualified from the tournament**
Results of all its games played shall be nullified



EFFECT OF FORFEIT IN A PLAYOFF SERIES

SCORESHEET PROCEDURE FOR CRITERIA 1 & 2

1. Enter the player list of the non-forfeiting team
2. Ask the Head Coach to indicate the 5 players to start the game and sign the scoresheet
3. Circle around the cross of the starting five players
4. Enter “ABSENT” across the player list section of the forfeiting team
5. Enter (20 – 0) in the final score in favour of the non-forfeiting team
6. All floor and table officials sign the scoresheet
7. Write the reason for forfeit on the back of the scoresheet

SCORESHEET PROCEDURE FOR CRITERIA 3 & 4

- 1. Close the running score section and note the game time remaining**
- 2. Enter the respective quarter scores in the Scores section**
- 3. Enter (20 – 0) in the final score in favour of the non-forfeiting team**
- 4. All floor and table officials sign the scoresheet**
- 5. Write the reason for forfeit on the back of the scoresheet**



SCORESHEET PROCEDURE FOR CRITERIA 3 & 4

CRITERIA 3: With 4:50 remaining in the 3rd quarter, Team B's actions prevent the game from being played. Hence Team A has won the match by Forfeit.

CRITERIA 4: With 4:50 remaining in the 3rd quarter, Team B refused to play after being requested by the Crew Chief. Hence Team A has won the match by Forfeit.
